#### Teach

- ✓ Classroom rules
- ✓ How we use different colored name sticks to take turns.
- ✓ Listening techniques (Brain Gym) for getting student attention/focus
- ✓ Discipline plan most basic consequences necessary for the first day or two
- ✓ Stop and listen signal ("One, two, three, eyes on me")

### **Teach and Practice**

- ✓ Where and how to put your things (cubby) including how to empty your backpack
- ✓ Opening procedures including how to sit in your chair, how to go to your table
- ✓ Rug procedures how to find a place to sit on the rug, how to salute the flag, how to say you need to go to the bathroom, listening to a story
- ✓ Snack and recess procedure how to get your snack, how to line up, where to eat, playground rules, equipment cleanup, lining up after recess
- ✓ Procedure for working at a table group
- ✓ End of the day procedure how to get your backpack, where to wait for parent/bus

- ✓ How to sit on rua
- ✓ How to find cubbies
- ✓ How to find bathrooms
- ✓ How to walk in line

- ✓ Hoe to leave when dismissed
- ✓ How and where to line up for school when the bell rings.

- ✓ How to greet each other and begin class
- ✓ How to retrieve/return text books
- ✓ How to retrieve/return correcting pens
- ✓ How to retrieve/return craft boxes for vocabulary cards
- ✓ How to chant declensions, conjugations
- ✓ How to prepare for pairs classwork or games
- ✓ How to prepare for listening music or news.
- ✓ How to signal to speak/answer
- ✓ How to turn in homework/classwork
- ✓ How to respond when timer signals "time up"
